



2018-2019 UNIFORM POLICY

Harriet Tubman Students are expected to be in complete uniform every day, Monday – Friday, from the minute they enter the school building.

Official Harriet Tubman Uniform:

Grades K-1-2	Grades 3-8
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A black Harriet Tubman polo shirt • Khaki uniform pants, shorts, or skorts (No joggers, skirts, jeans, or cut offs) • A plain black belt if belt loops (no studs, slogans, writing, or large buckles) • Solid black shoes, solid white shoes, or black and white shoes 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A Harriet Tubman polo shirt in the appropriate team color • If wearing an undershirt, must be solid white, black or grey • Khaki uniform pants, shorts, or skorts (No joggers, skirts, jeans, or cut offs) • A plain black belt (no studs, slogans, writing, or large buckles) • Solid black shoes, solid white shoes, or only black and white shoes • Solid black, white, or grey socks

Shoes

Students must wear hard sole uniform shoes or tennis shoes in solid black, solid white or black and white shoes. No color or combination of colors, other than black and white, are acceptable.

Socks

3-8 students wear solid black, white, or grey socks must be worn. Socks may not have a design or other colors on them.

School Sweaters

While students are allowed to wear coats and jacket to/from school, during the school day the only clothing worn over the uniform must be the school's black sweater or vest. School sweaters can be purchased in the school office.

Makeup and Nail Polish

Students may not wear makeup of any kind. Eye shadow, mascara, blush, lipstick and lip gloss are prohibited. Fingernail polish and fake nails of any kind are also prohibited.

Uniforms are Important!

As a school, we hold a firm line with our uniform policy in order to maintain consistency at the school. In order to prioritize academic learning time, we provide families choices to problem solve uniform issues.

<p>We will call home and ask which option you would like to take to problem solve the uniform issue:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parent can bring replacement item before 9AM. • Student can wear shoe covers. • Student can purchase a new belt for \$2.00. • If we cannot reach you, student will be billed for item. 	<p>In grades 3 - 8 we will not call home but send a letter home that evening.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Student can remove incorrect item and they can go to class. • Student can purchase a new belt/undershirt/socks for \$2.00 each <p>Student serves an afterschool detention the following day if the item cannot be corrected. Staff will communicate this via phone and in writing</p>
