UNIFORM POLICY

Our uniform policy reinforces our schools' culture of high expectations and academic achievement. Students are expected to wear a uniform every day Monday-Friday.

Uniform for the 2026-2027 School Year

Shirts: All students are required to wear a **Harriet Tubman** polo shirt (3-4-5: Teal / 6-7-8: Blue). Shirt tails must be tucked in and may not be worn outside of uniform bottoms.

Bottoms: Bottoms (pants, shorts, skirts, skorts, and scooters) are to be **navy-colored** dress, non-denim, uniform type bottoms. They are to be the appropriate size for the student, must fit properly at the waist, and may be neither too tight nor too baggy.

**** Note: We are phasing out **khaki pants and skirts** this school year. Students who have khaki bottoms from a prior school year may continue to wear these bottoms this year. **Khaki bottoms will not be permitted after the 26-27 school year.**

Skirts, skorts, and scooters may be worn only with shorts underneath. They must be at least knee-length.

Bell-bottoms, jeggings, cargo, corduroy, patch-pocketed, joggers, or jean type bottoms are not allowed as part of the uniform. Pants are to be hemmed (shoe-top length) and have no frayed edges or cut bottoms.

Uniform shorts, skirts, skorts, and scooters must be at least knee-length. They should not be rolled up at the waist.

Undershirt: Students may wear any color undershirt.

Belts: Belts are recommended but not required. If a scholar's pants do not fit properly around the waist, they will be required to wear a belt.

Socks: Students can wear any color socks or tights (they must be worn daily).

Shoes: Students can wear any color tennis shoes.

Outerwear: The only clothing worn over the uniform must be school-branded outerwear. **Tubman branded outerwear cannot be worn indoors if it is cut-off, frayed, or re-designed in any way.**
Note: Non-Tubman outerwear can be worn outdoors, but must be removed upon entering the building.

Headwear: Hats, caps, hoods, bandanas, handkerchiefs, visors, bonnets, headscarves, or other head coverings may NOT be worn in the building or in class (unless for religious purposes).

Accessories: Sunglasses are not allowed in the building or classroom (unless prescribed by a physician). No distracting or excessive jewelry or accessories will be allowed. No smart watches are allowed.

Student IDs: Name badge must be on the right collar.

Friday Uniform Policy Attire

On Friday, scholars are allowed to wear any Harriet Tubman shirt or college shirt with **blue, gray, or black jeans**. ***No jean shorts, jeans with rips, leggings, joggers, sweatpants, or shorts not part of the regular uniform are allowed.***

The following dress is unacceptable:

- * Shirts hanging out of pants
- * Pants hanging too low
- * Distracting jewelry, accessories, or sunglasses (unless prescribed by a physician)
- * Hats, caps, hoods, bandanas, handkerchiefs, visors, bonnets, or headscarves (unless for religious purposes)
- * Hoodies under uniform shirts or any sleepwear visible under the uniform
- * Flip flops, slippers, shoes with a heel, open toed shoes, or crocs
- * False nails beyond the natural length that hinder work
- * Rolled up pants legs
- * Cut-off pants legs
- * Eye shadow, blush, or lipstick

We also ask parents to support all decisions made by school staff regarding whether or not clothing is appropriate or inappropriate for school. Students who are out of uniform will remain in PREP until their uniform issue is addressed. Tubman staff will do all they can to communicate the uniform policy and to help resolve minor uniform infractions quickly to avoid a loss of instructional time.

If your child requires a religious accommodation to the uniform policy, please contact the school to discuss. If your child is experiencing homelessness or for any other reason needs financial assistance to procure a uniform, please contact the school to discuss.

Approved Uniform Bottoms
